## **About Abraham Accords:**

The Abraham Accord is a diplomatic agreement aimed at normalizing relations between Israel and Arab countries. It was signed on 15 September 2020 at the White House, Washington D.C., USA.

**Signatory Countries:** The initial signatories were Israel, United Arab Emirates (UAE), and the United States. Later, Bahrain, Sudan, and Morocco joined under similar frameworks.

**Objective:** To promote peace, stability, and cooperation in the Middle East through diplomatic recognition, trade, tourism, and technological collaboration.

## **Key Features:**

oEstablishment of formal diplomatic ties between Israel and signatory Arab nations.

oEncouragement of economic cooperation, direct flights, and cultural exchange.

oCommitment to resolve conflicts through dialogue rather than violence.

**Significance:** The accord reshapes Middle East geopolitics, reduces Arab-Israeli tensions, and strengthens strategic partnerships between the US and Gulf nations. Marks a shift in traditional alliances in the Middle East.
