

## **Alternatives for Tobacco Farmers**

The Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare (DA&FW) has been implementing **Crop Diversification Programme**(CDP), a sub-scheme of **Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana** (**RKVY**),in **10 tobacco growing states** of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal to encourage farmers to shift to alternative crops/cropping system since 2015-16.

Crop Diversification Programme (CDP) - a sub scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) is being implemented in Original Green Revolution States to divert the area of paddy crop to alternate crops and in tobacco growing states to encourage tobacco farmers to shift to alternate crops/cropping system.

**ICAR- Central Tobacco Research Institute, Rajahmundry**has recommended alternative cropping system to the States for replacing tobacco.

A total of 111889 acres land has been shifted from tobacco farming during last five years i.e. 2017-18 to 2021-22 to other alternative crops/cropping system
