- **Significance:** Dr. Sakthivel is credited with transforming **Tiruppur** into the "Knitwear Capital of India." His reappointment signals a focus on **Man-Made Fibre (MMF)** garments and Technical Textiles, which are currently underrepresented in India's export basket.
