Why is in news? Telangana: Bathukamma, floral festival begins across state; PM Modi greets everyone, auspicious occasion

In **Telangana**, Bathukamma, the **state floral festival** has begun with women in large numbers participating in the festivities across the state.

Every year this festival is celebrated **as per Sathavahana calendar for nine days**, usually in September–October of Gregorian calendar.

Bathukamma is celebrated for nine days during Durga Navratri.

Bathukamma represents **cultural spirit** of Telangana.

Bathukamma is a **beautiful flower stack**, **arranged with different unique seasonal flowers** most of them with medicinal values, in seven concentric layers in the shape of temple gopuram.

On particular Bathukamma festival is grandly **celebrated by young girls** in Telangana region of Telangana in India.

In Telugu, 'Bathukamma' means 'Mother Goddess come Alive'.

Historically, bathukamma meant "festival of life" and was celebrating crop harvest.
