The portal consists of five key modules:

Connect: Facilitates coordination between Indian law enforcement agencies and INTERPOL's NCB-New Delhi.

INTERPOL Notices: Enables swift identification of criminals both within India and globally.

References: Simplifies international requests for assistance in criminal investigations.

Broadcast: Ensures **prompt availability of assistance** requests from 195 countries.

About INTERPOL:

- Establishment: Founded in 1923, INTERPOL is the largest international police organization, with 196 member countries.
- Purpose: It facilitates global cooperation in combating international crime, supports training, issues criminal alerts, and manages databases related to criminal activity.
