Government Notifies National Sports Board Rules and National Sports Tribunal Rules, 2026

2026 and the National Sports Governance (National Sports Tribunal) Rules, 2026 under the provisions of the National Sports Governance Act, 2025. The move aims to strengthen transparency, accountability, governance standards, and dispute resolution mechanisms in Indian sports administration.

The newly notified rules establish two major institutions:

National Sports Board (NSB) – to oversee recognition and governance standards of National Sports Bodies.

National Sports Tribunal (NST) – to ensure speedy, independent, and cost-effective resolution of sports-related disputes.

The National Sports Board will monitor compliance with governance norms, ethical standards, athlete welfare, transparency, and fair elections in sports federations. Meanwhile, the National Sports Tribunal will function as an independent adjudicatory body for resolving disputes related to:

Athlete selection

Federation elections

Disciplinary actions

Governance conflicts

Sports administration matters.
