India has set a Guinness World Record for unfurling the largest national flag underwater at Radhanagar Beach in May 2026.?

The achievement was officially verified by Guinness World Records adjudicator.

The tricolour measured approximately 60 m × 40 m.

It is the world's largest underwater national flag.

The event took place at Swaraj Dweep (Havelock Island).
