- It is an **American origin Aircraft**.

- Role: **Coastal patrolling, maritime surveillance**, anti-submarine and anti-surface warfare, search-and-rescue, anti-piracy, and supporting operations of other arms of the military.
- Significance of P-8I's Participation: Reflects growing sophistication and complexity of joint operations.
