# India–Vietnam BrahMos Talks During Presidential Visit of Vietnam

During the visit of Vietnam's President To Lam to India (May 5–7, 2026), both countries are expected to discuss the possible sale of BrahMos missiles.

## What is being discussed?

India may offer BrahMos supersonic cruise missiles to Vietnam

These missiles are jointly developed by India and Russia

## Possible Deal Details:

Estimated value: around ₹5,800–6,000 crore (~\$600–700 million)

May include: Missiles supply & Training and logistics support

## Important Points:

Talks will focus on expanding defence cooperation between India and Vietnam

No final deal is expected to be signed immediately during the visit

Some defence-related announcements may still happen
