Training and awareness programs for pharmacists and stakeholders.

IPC–NIPER Hajipur Collaboration (Research Focus)

Joint research on impurity profiling (including genotoxic impurities like nitrosamines).

Development of analytical methods and quality control protocols.

Creation of standards for biologics, biosimilars, and gene/cell therapies.

Academic exchange, training, internships, and fellowships.
