About Quantum City:

Quantum Innovation Hub: The Quantum City is planned as a comprehensive innovation hub, featuring research labs, a Quantum Hardware Park, cryogenic testing facilities, quantum cloud/data centers, and a deep-tech startup district.

Ecosystem: The Quantum City will offer end-to-end support for quantum technologies, covering research, incubation, and commercialisation.

Quantum Supremacy Centre: Karnataka will establish a Rs.1,136?crore Quantum Supremacy Centre in Bengaluru to focus on quantum chip fabrication.
