

Khajuraho Temples

Khajuraho Temples (in Madhya Pradesh) are among the most beautiful medieval monuments in the country.

It was built between 950-1050 AD by the Chandela Dynasty.

The monuments include **Hindand Jain temples**.

The temple site is situated within Vindhya Mountain range.

These Temples got the status of UNESCO's World Heritage Sites in 1986.

The temples are famous for their Nagara-style architectural symbolism.

Reported for the first time by **AbRihan al Biruni** in AD 1022 and Ibn Battuta in AD 1335.

Most temples were built during the reigns of the **Hindkings Yashovarman and Dhanga**. Yashovarman's legacy is best exhibited by the **Lakshmana Temple**.

Of the surviving temples, the **Kandariya Mahadeva Temple** is decorated with a profusion of sculptures with intricate details, symbolism and expressiveness of ancient Indian art.
