Godavari River

- The **Godavari River** is one of the **major and sacred rivers of India**, also known as the **“Ganga of the South” (Dakshin Ganga)**.
- It is the **second longest river in India**, originating from **Trimbakeshwar in Maharashtra** and draining into the **Bay of Bengal**.
- It is the **largest river system of Peninsular India**, flowing through **Maharashtra, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, and Odisha**.
- The **total length of the river is about 1,465 km (910 miles)**. Due to its **vastness and religious significance**, it is also called the **“Old Ganga”**.
- The **drainage basin of the Godavari River is about 3,12,812 sq km**.
- It **empties into the Bay of Bengal**.
- **Trimbakeshwar Temple (a Jyotirlinga of Lord Shiva)** is located near Nashik on its banks
- **Nashik city** is situated on the banks of the Godavari River
- **Kumbh Mela (Simhastha)** is held every **12 years at Nashik on its banks**
- **Bhadrachalam** is an important religious site located on its banks
- The river is a major source of irrigation in the delta regions of **Andhra Pradesh and Telangana**
- **Rajahmundry** city in Andhra Pradesh lies on its banks
- **The Godavari Delta** is highly fertile and known for rice cultivation

Spratly Islands

- The **Spratly Islands dispute** is a territorial conflict over the Spratly Island group.
- The **Spratly Islands** are located in the **South China Sea**.
- The countries claiming sovereignty over these islands include **Vietnam, China, Taiwan, Malaysia, the Philippines, and Brunei**. Except **Brunei**, all countries occupy at least some of the islands.
- The **South China Sea** is rich in oil and gas resources. However, most of these islands are involved in boundary disputes.
- Apart from China, **Vietnam and several other countries have also laid claims** over these islands. For example, **Vietnam has long claimed the Paracel Islands**, which were occupied by China in 1974.
- Both **Vietnam and China claim the Spratly Islands**. In June 2007, British company **BP canceled its oil exploration plan** in a block between Vietnam and the Spratly Islands.
- The reason cited was the **ongoing dispute between Vietnam and China over the ownership of this maritime region**.
