Middle East Green Initiative:

Saudi Arabia launched Saudi Green Initiative and the Middle East Green Initiative to combat the threat of climate change.

Aim: To preserve marine and coastal environments, increase the proportion of natural reserves and protected land, improve the regulation of oil production, accelerate the transition to clean energy and boost the amount of energy generated by renewables.

Saudi Arabia will work with the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries and regional partners to plant an additional 40 billion trees in the West Asian region to reduce 2.5 per cent of global carbon levels.

Saudi Arabia has been sharing its expertise and know-how with its neighbouring countries to **reduce carbon** emissions resulting from hydrocarbon production in the region by 60 per cent and globally by 10 per cent.

Under it, the annual summit will host leaders from the government, scientists and environmentalists to discuss the details of implementation.
