Why is in news? PM shares glimpses of Parshuram Kund Festival in Arunachal Pradesh

Parshuram Kund is a **Hindu pilgrimage sites** situated on the Brahmaputra plateau in the lower reaches of the **Lohit River** and 21 km north of Tezu in Lohit district of **Arunachal Pradesh**, India.

Parshuram Kund is situated within the **Kamlang Reserve Forest area** in Lohit District. The Kund is surrounded by **dense forest of Ruddraksha trees**, the fruit of which is considered sacred to Hindu ascetics as well as general believers of the faith.

Dedicated to **sage Parshuram**, and it is believed that Lord Parashuram the sixth incarnation of **Lord Vishnu**, the popular site attracts pilgrims from Nepal, from across India, and from nearby states of Manipur and Assam.

Over 70,000 devotees and sadhus take a holy dip in its water each year on the **occasion of Makar Sankranti**, in the month of January.
