



QUAD NAVAL EXERCISE MALABAR 2025 BEGINS AT GUAM, NORTHERN PACIFIC OCEAN

On November 10 2025, the 29th edition of the multilateral Exercise Malabar(2025) began at Guam in the Northern Pacific Ocean (NPO), hosted by the United States of America (USA).

- The nine-day Quad naval exercise, involving the navies of India, the USA, Japan, and Australia, will run until 18 November 2025.

About Exercise MALABAR 2025:

Scope: The exercise will include advanced maritime operations such as high-tempo drills and fleet manoeuvres, aimed at strengthening coordination and interoperability among the Quad navies.

Phases: The exercise will be conducted in two phases :the Harbour Phase from November 10–12, 2025, followed by the Sea Phase from November 13–17, 2025.

- Harbour Phase : Focused on operational planning, communication alignment, familiarisation visits, and sports interactions among participating navies.

Sea Phase : Involves complex naval drills at sea, including joint fleet operations, anti-submarine warfare (ASW), gunnery serials, and cross-deck flying exercises
