

Remodelling the UAE – India aviation partnership

Context

As the pace of growth in **India's aviation sector** — it is already the **world's third-largest** domestic market in terms of passenger numbers — continues to quicken and the Government of India's initiatives such as the Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik (UDAN) airport scheme are rapidly implemented, it is essential that an equally visionary approach to regulation and international partnerships is also considered.

For decades, the **United Arab Emirates (UAE)** has proven itself to be a close **strategic partner** and friend to India. Today, the UAE is India's most significant outbound travel market, with over 4.5 million Indian tourists visiting the UAE in 2023.

Every week, Indian carriers fly over 600 times to the UAE, while UAE carriers operate over 500 weekly services to India. On the surface, these numbers appear significant. However, they are far below meeting current, let alone, future consumer demand.

UDAN Scheme (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik)

It is a regional airport development and "Regional Connectivity Scheme" (RCS) of the Union Government of India.

It was initially launched on October 21, 2016, for a 10-year period.

The primary objective of the scheme is to provide **affordable and efficient air travel options** to residents of **tier-2 and tier-3 cities**, remote areas, and regions with limited or no air connectivity.

The scheme envisages providing connectivity to **unserved and underserved regions** of the country through the revival of existing airstrips and airports.
