About:

The Scindia School is a **private boarding school for boys**, **established in 1897**, and situated in the **historic Gwalior Fort**, in the city of Gwalior.

It was **originally started exclusively for royals and nobles of Indian princely states**, particularly the Marathas, though it no longer discriminates on class.

In 2010, the school enrolled 606 students, with a teacher: student ratio of 1:12.

The Scindia School was founded by the **late Maharaja Madho Rao Scindia of Gwalior in 1897**, as the Sardar School.

It was renamed, "The Scindia School", in 1933, as it **evolved into a public school** with a Board of Governors, presently headed by Jyotiraditya Scindia, scion of Scindia family.

Maharaja Sir Madho Rao Scindia of Gwalior (20 October 1876 – 5 June 1925), was the **5th Maharaja of Gwalior** belonging to the Scindian dynasty of the Marathas.
