The term “*Global South*” refers to various countries often described as “*developing,*” “*less developed*” or “*underdeveloped.*” The concept of the Global South can be traced to the *Brandt report of 1980.*

§*Brandt Line*: Proposed by **German Chancellor Willy Brandt in the 1980s**, this line visually depicts the *global north-south economic divide, based on per-capita GDP*, spanning Africa, the Middle East, India, and China, while excluding Australia and New Zealand.

India’s initiatives for Global south:

India has taken several initiatives for South-South cooperation, including the

§**induction of the African Union into the G20 Grouping,**

§**International Solar Alliance, Global Biofuel Alliance, and**

§**Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure.**

Initiatives such as **MAHARISHI** focus on global food security, while the **G20 Digital Public Infrastructure Framework** aim to enhance collaboration and address shared challenges among Global South
